Herb, 88, died peacefully on April 25, 2023 at his home in Blue Ridge Shores, Louisa. He was born July

8, 1934 in Brooklyn, NY to German immigrants, Paul and Louise Bauer, and is survived by his wife of over 50 years, Donya Bauer. Herb graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1957 and obtained a Masters Degree in International Affairs from George Washington University in 1967. He retired from the Navy with the rank of Captain in 1983 having commanded submarines (USS Sirago), battleships and aircraft carriers. He was a member of Post 116 and resided in Blue Ridge Shores. Curt Bean – Local Chapter Lead for Guitars 4 Vets will be attending our June Meeting.


What is G4Vets? Playing a guitar can help veterans safely connect with their surroundings and other people.

Per their website: 800,000 U.S. veterans struggle with physical injuries, PTSD and other emotional distress. We believe guitars can help the healing process. Music helps decrease anxiety, increase self-esteem, and reduce episodes of panic attacks, nightmares and flashbacks. A research study of Guitars 4 Vets students showed a 21% improvement in PTSD symptoms and a 27% decrease in related depression symptoms. The study attributed learning and playing guitar as the primary catalysts for these improvements—and we want to ensure as many vets as possible have that opportunity.
