MEETING RECAP



Four Chaplains Remembrance

The Post will be honoring the 80th Anniversary of sinking of the Dorchester. This story is very important to remember because on Feb. 3, 1943, while crossing the North Atlantic, transporting troops to an American base in Greenland; a German U-boat fired a torpedo and sank the ship, killing 672 of the 902 officers and enlisted men, merchant seamen and civilian workers aboard. Many of those survivors owe their lives to the courage and leadership exhibited by four chaplains of different faiths, who, in sacrificing their lives, created a unique legacy of brotherhood. Post will have a display set up in February.
